These problems are real and have real long-term consequences...And they are the reason St. Vincent Family Center is here.

- One in 5 children has a diagnosable mental disorder.
- One in 10 children has serious emotional disturbance with substantial functional impairment.
- One in 20 children, faces extreme functional impairment.
- Nearly 17,000 children and adolescents in Franklin County need help, yet only 57% will receive services.
- Early detection and treatment are vital. St. Vincent Family Center has a 93% success rate integrating preschool children from therapeutic services back into their traditional preschool.
- Our Therapeutic Preschool and School Age programs serve children who have been expelled from school for their behavior. By educating them while they are receiving daily treatment, the children are able to learn skills that will allow them to return to their school and be successful.
- For young children with severe pediatric behavioral health issues, St. Vincent Family Center is oftentimes their only hope. Our Residential Services is the only program in central Ohio that provides shelter and treatment for children as young as 5 years old.
